


Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd December 2023

### From the Pastor's Desk:

"Do not be afraid; for see—I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign for you: you will find a child wrapped in bands of cloth and lying in a manger." Luke 2:10b-12.

While it might not be the most theologically rich vision of this verse I can't help but hear Linus's voice from the Charlie Brown Christmas special after Charlie Brown asks him what Christmas is all about. Linus gets up and says, "I can tell you what Christmas is all about Charlie Brown" and then he quotes this Scripture from Luke's Gospel. This then becomes the "aha" moment that all the fuss over the Christmas play, the lights contest, and the perfect tree don't really matter in the end. I wouldn't go so far as to say that all those things don't matter. Our traditions matter and the warm, loving feelings we get participating in them matter. It only becomes a problem when we get lost in stress and forget what we are really celebrating, which Luke's Gospel reminds us of every year. As we enter into the Advent season of waiting and anticipation for Christ's birth on December 25 make sure you are taking time to make space for Christ to enter. In the midst of the shopping, parties, and holiday rush, make space for prayer, for taking 5 minutes of quiet contemplation, to take time to ponder all the wonderful things that surround us this time of year. After Jesus's birth and all the visitations there is a verse that says that Mary took it all in and then pondered it all in her heart. Take the memories of Christmas's past, the love of family and friends, the celebrations of this year, and the love of Christ that brings them all together and ponder them in your heart. Amen!

### **Choir:**






### **ELCA NEWS:**

#### ELCA Church Council appoints the Rev. Michael Burk as Presiding Bishop Pro Tempore

The Church Council of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) appointed the Rev. Michael Burk as presiding bishop pro tempore after its Executive Committee approved Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton's request for a four- to six-month leave of absence, to begin Nov. 17. The council, which serves as the ELCA churchwide organization's board of directors and interim legislative authority between meetings of a churchwide assembly, gathered at the Lutheran Center in Chicago, Nov. 9-12.
