

Adult Education Class:



Daily Bread Ministry:



We currently have 15 residents at the camp; one resident receives Social Security; seven residents have jobs, three have applied for disability, and two residents were able to move into housing this month. We were able to help three people receive Georgia IDs this month, two receive their Social Security, and one to receive Food Stamps. In addition to serving those at the camp, we serve approximately forty-four individuals who live outside Shinnah in

unsupervised camps. We serve approximately 90 individuals who live in housing that have no transportation.

We were blessed to be able to give Loving Hands Ministry a small monetary donation...This week Loving Hands helped three families into temporary housing. These Moms and children were homeless and in the rain in Douglasville.

Our needs this month are canned soups and peanut butter. Thank you to all those who serve and donate to this ministry. You make a difference!
